Income Verification for Fee Waiver

You must present one from the following list of documents to verify income:

- Two current pay stubs for all working members of
- Disability statement showing benefits the household
- Current tax returns
- Unemployment statement showing benefits
- Foster placement papers
- Medicaid Card showing case number
- Food Stamp Evidence
- Direct Certification letter from the State of Illinois
- Temporary Food assistance for needy families

You may be requested to provide updated income verification at any time, but no more often than once every 60 calendar days. Supplying false information to obtain a fee waiver is a Class 4 felony (720 ILCS 5/17-6). I attest that the statements made herein are true and correct.
