Thank you for writing to Jacksonville School District 117 with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.

On March 14, 2022, JSD 117 was in receipt of your request for directory information for all students specifically students name, students grade level, students name of school and parents email addresses.

As the FOIA Officer for Jacksonville School District 117 I am writing to inform you that your request is denied for the following reason:

- Section 20.38 of 105 ILCS 5/10 states, “A school district, including its agents, employees, student or alumni associations, or any affiliates, may not provide a student's name, address, telephone number, social security number, e-mail address, or other personal identifying information to a business organization...”

You have a right to have the denial reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:
